All breeds of dogs, including mixes, may compete and title in ASCA trials. Simply register your dog with ASCA using the Tracking Number Application form included in this premium.

Notice that exhibitors, through submission of entries, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of and agree to follow ASCA rules and regulations and FLAG's trial policies, including but not limited to the following:

- This trial is open to all dogs, purebred or otherwise, at least 18 months of age.
- Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause the judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform the obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health, and welfare of the dog. Any dog that demonstrates aggression towards any person or any other dog, whether inside or outside the ring, must be excused from the trial, as will any dog which the judge feels is not in enough control to perform all obstacles in a safe manner. Any owner, handler, or spectator exhibiting poor sportsmanship or abuse towards a dog or person will be required to leave the show site for the duration of the trial.
- Bitches in heat are not allowed on the trial site. Bitches that come into heat or dogs that become injured before the closing date may have their entry fees refunded, less \$25.00, pending proof by veterinarian. Refund to be made after the trial closing date. No other refunds will be made after trial closing date. Overpayments below \$10 will be returned only upon request otherwise such overpayments will go to the Lufkin Humane Society..
- This show will be held under the current rules and regulations of ASCA. A copy of the rulebook may be obtained from the ASCA web site at www.asca.org.
- All dogs, at all levels, not jumping 16" Vet/JH, 16+" Vet/JH, 20", 20+", or 24" must be measured. Dogs with permanent jump height cards do not require measuring. ASCA accepts only NADAC or AKC height cards.
- No leads, collars, food, toys, etc. shall be permitted on the course at any time.
- All dogs must be on leash or securely crated when not competing in the ring.
- Safety shall always be the foremost consideration in actions by handlers at all times.
- The organizing committee may refuse any entry on the basis expressly provided through ASCA rules and regulations. Anyone not currently in good standing with ASCA will not be allowed entry into the trial.
- Entries must be made on the enclosed entry forms. Copies may be made if entire form is copied. No other forms will be accepted. Entries must be signed to be valid.
- Make all checks and money orders payable to FLAG (Fast Lane Agility Group). Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and there will be a \$35.00 service fee on all returned checks. Entry into future trials and participation in this trial will not be allowed until all fees are paid in cash or money order. Illegible or incomplete entry forms do not constitute a valid entry.
- Dog sales or puppies under eight weeks old are not permitted on the trial site.
- FLAG, ASCOT, its board of directors, ASCA, management, and the property owner assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by the exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs, personal property, and/or children.

Food

Restaurants: If you continue around Loop 287 heading east approximately 5 miles, you will see Olive Garden, Cheddars, Chili's and Logan's on the left and Red Lobster on the right. Take the S. First Street exit to get to these restaurants. If you continue on Loop 287 and take Hwy 59 south, you will see Outback on your right and Cotton Patch and Ralph and Kacoo's on left.

Fast Food: Take Loop 287 east around to the south side of town approximately 5 miles, then take hwy 59 south and there's a McDonald's on the left. Or take Loop 287 east (left), go ½ mile and take the Hwy 59 south exit, go 3-4 miles and there is a KFC, Burger King, Taco Bell, Pizza Hut, etc.

Running Order

The running order will be provided in your final confirmation letter the week before the trial. Please note that we will be running alternating rings. We will run in one ring while the other ring is being built and opened for walk-through.

ASCA Service Membership and Tracking Number Application

Beginning 1/1/2003 for non-ASCA registered dogs – In order to have ASCA qualifying legs tracked and to receive ASCA titling certificates, each non-ASCA registered dog will be required to have an ASCA Tracking Number. This is a one-time fee of \$10/dog. At the time of applying for the tracking number, the individual owner must also be an ASCA member (minimum membership type of 'Service' is required). ASCA membership does not need to be maintained in subsequent years. **It will be the responsibility of the owner to identify to ASCA the show(s) and leg(s) earned when applying for a Tracking Number for those ASCA qualifying legs earned from 1/1/2003 until submission of application.** Please type or print clearly. Incomplete or illegible forms will be returned.

Directions

From Dallas take 175 south to Jacksonville. This will tee into 69 - turn right (south) on 69 at the light passing through Jacksonville, Rusk, Alto and Wells. Hwy 69 will become the Loop 287 (Ellen Trout Drive) and you will bear off to the left. When you pass the crossroad of FM 2251, continue on the loop for another 1/2 mile, get in the left-hand lane, and you will see a crossover. You will see Brookshire Bros. Corporate Office up ahead on the right. As you turn left into the crossover, you will see Ellen Trout Park Zoo on the left and the George Henderson Expo Center (large blue and gray building) on the right. Go straight and take the second driveway to the right. Concrete parking lot. Pavilion will be on your left after entering parking lot.

From Ft. Worth I-45 south to Corsicana/Athens exit. Stay on 31 until you reach Athens, then turn right on 175 and follow the Dallas directions above.

From Houston Take 59 North passing through Cleveland, Livingston, Corrigan, Diboll. In Lufkin, take Loop 287 north/east, passing the Hwy 59 north exit, until you reach the Brookshire Bros. Corporate Office on the left. You will see a sign on the right that says George H. Henderson Expo Center on the right. It is a very large blue and gray building. Turn right after seeing the Expo sign, and go to the second entrance on the right. Pavilion will be on your left after entering parking lot.

Show 'N Go Friday Night

FLAG is hosting a Show 'N Go at the arena on Friday from 5 to 8 PM.

No pre-entry is required, sign up at the show site. Leashes and toys are allowed. \$5 per dog for 90 seconds in the ring.

Other Important Info

Catalogs/Run Orders - No catalogs will be printed. Running orders will be posted at the gates. Handlers with multiple dogs will be separated as much as the class allows.

Move-Ups - All move-up requests must be received by the trial secretary before **November 10, 2010**. There will be **NO move-ups offered on the day of the trial**.

Cancellation of Entries - Cancellation of entries due to exhibitor request prior to the trial closing date will be subject to a processing fee of \$25 at the discretion of the club. Refund of any entry fees following cancellation requests made after trial closing will be at the discretion of the club.

Obstacle Specification – The obstacles that will be made available to the judge of the trial are: Dog Walk, A-Frame, Teeter, Closed Tunnel, Open Tunnel, Weave Poles, Non-Winged Single Hurdles, Winged Single Hurdles, and Double Bar Hurdle. Dogwalk and A-Frame will be slat-less.

Prizes and Awards –FLAG will award strip ribbons for 1st through 4th places and to each qualifying score. Additional awards may be offered at club's discretion.

Pre-Novice – We are offering two regular Pre-Novice classes on Saturday only.

ASCA Dog Bite Policy-

1) A judge shall disqualify any dog that attempts to attack any person in the ring/trial arena, as determined by the judge. The judge shall excuse a dog that attacks another dog or appears to the judge to be threatening other dogs in the ring/trial arena. The judge shall mark the dog "disqualified" or "excused" in accordance with this Rule, shall state the reason in the Judge's Book or scoresheet, and shall give the Show/Trial Secretary a brief report of the dog's actions using the Disqualified or Excused Dog form, which shall be submitted to ASCA with the report of the show/trial. The entry form for any Disqualified or Excused dogs must be submitted with the Show/Trial Results. Any dog which has been excused on two (2) occasions pursuant to this Rule shall be disqualified to compete in any subsequent ASCA event unless and until it is reinstated by the Board of Directors. Notice of disqualification will be sent to the owner by the Business Office after review by the Board of Directors.

2) A dog that, in the opinion of the judge, menaces, threatens or exhibits any sign that it may not be safely approached or examined by the judge in the normal manner may be excused from the Show/Trial arena and be subject to this Rule.

- 1.1. As used here 'ASCA' means Australian Shepherd Club of America, its affiliate clubs and each of their members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- 1.2. Exhibitor/owner, agree to abide by the rules and regulations of ASCA and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 1.3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs, or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- 1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fitting, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
- 1.5. Exhibitor/owner release ASCA, FLAG, FAST, and ASCOT (including their officers, directors, and members, and event organizing committees), George Henderson Expo Center (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury, or death may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.
